In essence it is a national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country. Peter McGuire, known as a "disturber of the public peace" in his time was the prominent figure behind the creation of this holiday. In 1894 Congress voted to make it a federal holiday.
