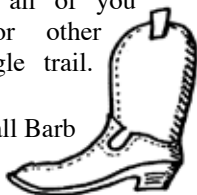
Message from the Marshall

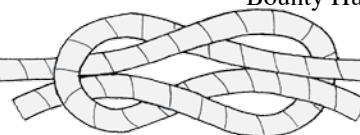
