REMEMBER THE MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES

WHEN SUBMITTING A REPORT TO THE STATE CHAIRMAN INCLUDE:

- NUMBER OF PEOPLE WORKING ON PROJECT.
- 2. HOURS SPENT FOR EACH PERSON WHO WORKED.
- 3. TOTAL NUMBER OF MILES TRAVELED.
- 4. REPORT ALL PROJECTS RELATED TO COMMUNITY SERVICE BY AUXILIARY AND AUXILIARY MEMBERS WHO HELPED.
- 5. MAKE SURE REPORT OS POSTMARKED BY MAY 15, SENT TO THE STATE PROJECT CHAIRMAN FOR THAT YEAR.
